I very often find deceased birds that have run into the windows of campus buildings and it happens far more frequently than you would expect. When I walk on campus in the evenings, I have found birds anywhere from twice a month, to twice a week. Most of the birds I have found have been on the north side of the L3Harris Center for Sci &Eng, and especially on the East-side of Gordon L. Nelson Health Sciences. After Milton, I found 3 dead birds on the alcove in the northeast corner of the building. L3HarrisCommons also frequently experiences birds running into its windows. I'm suggesting that the university look into investing in some kind of prevention (netting?) at least in the areas where it is a common occurrence. It is distressing to see, especially since it is so frequent.
