The nonrefundable \$500 program registration fee should be paid into the Oxford Program account at the Student Accounts window on the first floor of the L3Harris Commons Building on Babcock Street. If you are not on main campus, payments can be made by phone. Contact the program director for guidance. Scan and email the receipt to hwautlet@fit.edu along with your application. The \$500 registration fee will be refunded only to those students who are not selected for the program (due to academic standing, etc.).

- 4. A \$500 nonrefundable registration fee made payable to Florida Institute of Technology. This fee is deducted from your program balance.
- 5. Please include a copy of the photo page of your passport if you have one.

#### Once your application is received, you will be notified via email within two weeks of the status of your application.
